Eagle Scout Rank - Worksheet

Remember the skills learned for Scout, Tenderfoot, Second & First Class Ranks

- While a Life Scout, plan, develop, and give leadership to others in a service project helpful to any religious institution, any school, or your community. (The project should benefit an organization other than Boy Scouting.) The project plan must be approved by the organization benefiting from the effort, your Scoutmaster and troop committee and the council or district before you start. You must use the Eagle Scout Leadership Service Project Workbook, BSA publication No. 18-927E, in meeting this requirement.

- Be active in your troop and patrol for at least 6 months as a Life Scout.

- While a Life Scout, serve actively 6 months in one or more of the positions of responsibility:

Senior Patrol Leader, Assistant Senior Patrol Leader, Venture Patrol Leader, Patrol Leader, Order of the Arrow Troop Representative Junior Assistant Scoutmaster, Chaplain's Aide, Troop Guide, Den Chief, Scribe, Librarian, Historian, Quartermaster, Bugler or Instructor

- Earn total of at least 21 merit badges, including 12 Eagle Required badges:

First Aid, Communications, Personal Fitness, Family Life, Environmental Science, Citizenship in the Community, Citizenship in the Nation, Citizenship in the World, Personal Management, Camping, +Emergency Preparedness OR Lifesaving, +Swimming OR* Hiking OR* Cycling*

** You must earn one of these alternate requirements – more you earn can be counted towards your 9 non-Eagle required badges*

- Demonstrate that you live by the principles of the Scout Oath and Law in your daily life.
- List the names of individuals who know you personally and would be willing to provide a recommendation on your behalf, including parents/guardians, religious, educational, and employer references.
- Complete a Scoutmaster conference.
- Successfully complete an Eagle Scout board of review
