

Troop 278 – Ahwatukee Scout Rank Worksheet

Parent & Scout based requirements:

- Complete an application form and submit to the Troop*
- Complete a medical history form and submit to the Troop
- Complete the 'Child Abuse Prevention Pamphlet' exercise with your Scout

Scout Knowledge/Skills based requirements:

You must understand and be able to repeat from memory:

- The Pledge of Allegiance

Be ready to live by and recite: (*recite - following someone else*)

- The Scout Oath/Promise
- The Scout Law
- The Scout Motto
- The Scout Slogan
- The Outdoor Code

- Demonstrate the Scout Sign, Salute & Handshake
- Learn: When a Scout leader makes the Scout Sign stop what you are doing - stay still - be quiet - and also make the Scout sign yourself. If you see other Scout Troop members make the Scout sign - pay attention, this is the way Scout leaders get attention and calm the Troop down.
- Demonstrate tying the Square Knot (*AKA Reef Knot*)
- Describe The Scout Badge and the meanings of its component parts

- Participate in a Scoutmaster Conference to demonstrate & discuss all the above items and get your Membership Application approved and your Scout Rank signed off.
